## **ELIGIBILITY**

In order to be eligible for the KNR Don't Text & Drive Scholarship, applicants must:

- Be a United States citizen or permanent resident.
- ♥ Be accepted to or currently enrolled in an accredited college, university, or graduate program within the United States.
- Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher.
- Demonstrate good character and high initiative.

## <equation-block> REQUIREMENTS

Applicants must submit the following documents to be considered:

- A completed application form.
- A current high school, college, or graduate school transcript (unofficial copies are acceptable).
- ✓ A letter of recommendation from a teacher or faculty member.



Applicants will be required to develop a plan to encourage young adults to avoid texting & driving. The plan can be very open-ended. Applicants can make videos, submit strategies, or be as creative as they'd like to convey their ideas.



- The application and supporting material must be received by March 31st, 2018.
- The scholarship winner will be notified by email prior to April 30th, 2018.

The scholarship must be applied to tuition and other education-related expenses. A check will be made payable to the recipient's educational institution directly. You are expected to submit any receipts to remain in compliance with the IRS.
