If you have more than two students at Edison Elementary please visit the third child's classroom after your 6:30 meeting. It would be greatly appreciated if you could attend each of your child's grade level meetings to hear expectations from the homeroom teacher. Each grade level has different expectations so we want to make sure you receive this valuable information for each of your children.
