


# PROGRESSBOOK: PARENT ACCESS – **Setting up Alerts**

If your school or district has enabled alerts in ProgressBook, you can subscribe to these alerts if you want to be notified when you have not completed an assignment or when you have received a low grade (mark). You can choose the types of alerts you want to receive.

**Note:** Low assignment mark alerts are not available for standards-based classes.



**STEP 1:** To subscribe to alerts, on the navigation bar, click **Alerts**.

**STEP 2:** On the **Alerts** screen, under **Alert Settings**, next to your name, select the alerts you want to receive.

**STEP 3:** Under **Alert Emails** add "Your Email Address" in the text box and click **Add New Email**

**STEP 4:** Click **Update**

STEP 5: If you selected the Low Assignment Marks alert check box, select the threshold grades as follows:

### Low Mark Alert Settings

Send alerts for grades equal to or less than:

Class	Grade
ART 7	C

STEP 6: Under **Low Mark Alert Settings**, for each class for which you want to set a low mark alert, in the **Grade** drop-down list, select a threshold grade. (For example, if you want to be notified if you receive a grade of "C" or lower, select "C.")

b. Click **Update**

**Note:** For classes that use standards-based grading, you cannot select a threshold grade.
